Is your child "itching" to sing and dance on stage? The RJTG "Musical Review" Program is a comprehensive introduction to musical theater, giving children 7 and older a chance to audition, rehearse and perform a medley of Broadway-style musical numbers *within* the show for the "Musical Production" Program. Two public performances of an original version of "42nd Street" starring both casts will be held on Tuesday, 7/21 and Thursday, 7/23. There's even a cast party on Wednesday, 7/22! Attendance at the first two classes is mandatory for auditions and any significant absences between 7/7-7/23 could result in a role change. Class size limited to 20 students.

Session Fee: \$295

Is your budding star looking for a chance to grow their performing skills and experience? This summer, RJTG's "Musical Production" students will get a comprehensive musical theater experience in an original junior version of the Broadway hit, "42nd Street." From auditions, to rehearsals and finally two live performances, students will come away with stage instruction and direction in acting, singing, dancing and more...there's even a cast party! Performances will be 7/21 and 7/23 with a cast party on 7/22. Attendance is required the first week of class for auditions and any absences between 7/6-7/23 could result in a role change. Class size limited to 25 students.
