

## AMES PTA MINUTES

August 23, 2018

- I. Call to Order 8:31 by Domenica Jimenez, President of Ames PTA, (Susan Wolfe, co-pres)
- II. Principal Todd Gierman and Superintendent Martha Ryan-Toye
  - A. Mr. Gierman has an “open door” policy if you or your kids need to reach out for any reason, he wants everyone to feel comfortable in doing so.
  - B. There are a few new teachers to Ames, including Ms. Amy Seymour in 5<sup>th</sup> grade and Ms. Gabrielle Wydra a resource teacher.
  - C. The school addition and space planning are an ongoing discussion and we are fully committed to making the green space work for us. The grass seeds have been planted and should be usable in a month or so, but we need to see how the space drains water and potential flooding in area. Also, a plan has to be established in regards to fencing and weed removal and how to access the green space once the grass is in. Stay tuned for an update on when green space will be fully accessible.
  - D. School Board, even though no one is from the Ames school area, is fully committed to focusing on our addition and how best to transform our space, according to our Superintendent. Timeline is still uncertain.
  - E. There seems to be funding and stipends for Afterschool Clubs, and we are wondering how to get more offered at Ames. According to Mr. Gierman, each school gets allotted one club and beyond that we have to apply and it gets worked into teachers’ salaries. Now that he knows there is an interest, he will try to see what else we can bring to Ames.
