### **PTA Meeting Minutes**

Friday, November 4, 2011

- Minutes from previous PTA Meeting on October 4<sup>th</sup> were approved.
- Melanie Lanni, new ELL teacher: On behalf of Ames teachers, thank you to the PTA for Grandparents Day. The kids loved it!

Question: What is an ELL teacher? Answer: Ms. Lanni is a bilingual teacher who works with students whose native language is not English.

# • Dr. Jon Lamberson, D96 Superintendant

- Last year D96 students got the highest ISAT scores in history. D96 ISAT results are available on the district website (<a href="www.district96.org">www.district96.org</a>) under "About District 96/Report Card". The steady improvement in ISAT scores has occurred during a 42% enrollment growth.
- D96 earned the Bright Red Apple award and Ames earned the Illinois State Board of Education Academic Excellence Award.
- D96 was invited again this year by Apple to apply for the Apple leadership award.
- D96 was among 20% of school districts in Illinois to receive the Illinois State Board of Education award for good fiscal stewardship.
- The Board will be reviewing bids for capital improvement construction and will vote on whether to approve the bids in February. Construction would begin at all schools this summer, to be completed over the summer. Plans being considered for Ames can be viewed at www.district96.org and include the following:
  - Multipurpose room relocated to the first floor, and current multipurpose room converted into 2 classrooms, and a science lab where the kitchen was located.
  - New gym floor
  - Heating redone and A/C added
  - All classrooms renovated; including new floor and ceiling tile, lighting and fans
  - All nonfunctioning electrical replaced. Adding new electrical plugs as needed
  - Ceiling-mounted projector screen installed in every classroom
  - Phones in every classroom, and new intercom speakers
  - Individual cubbies for students
  - Switching the location of the school office and the library; this would increase safety
    in that all school visitors would proceed through front doors directly to the office

### • Colleen Lieggi, Ames School Principal

- Thank you to the PTA for the Halloween Assembly, and for Grandparents Day. There were 230 grandparents there! The teaching staff suggested that we consider switching the time so that the grandparents visit during the hour right before lunch.
- Thank you to the Ames staff for their Fall Auction donations and for attending the Auction.
- Veterans Day is Nov. 11<sup>th</sup> and students should wear red, white and blue, and invite any
  veterans they know to attend the assembly.
- Report cards will go home on November 18<sup>th</sup>, and Parent/Teacher conferences are the following Monday. Parents should come to the conferences prepared and write down any

questions beforehand, as the meetings are only 15 minutes long and the teachers must keep to their schedules.

- A Global Connections Committee made up of teachers, parents, and administrators has been formed. The focus of the committee is to come up with global learning projects for each grade level.
- Ames School received the 2011 Bright Red Apple Award for the first time!
- Overall ISAT scores for Ames school are available on <u>www.district96.org</u>. The scores are
  used to identify strengths and weaknesses of student and of teachers. It can also identify
  at-risk students.
