Administration Report, Principal Lieggi -

- Principal Lieggi provided the teacher's report. The teachers appreciate the Medieval Math program and thank the committee for providing the tracking sheet. The teachers agree with the decision to not provide a Halloween snack to the students.
- The first PUMPED celebration was a "Rock, Paper, Scissors Tournament" held on November 1st. All children without conduct referrals participated and the event was a great success.
- Executives from Apple will meet with some of the District 96 faculty at Hauser School on November 10th to discuss the Laptop Initiative and technology in the classrooms. Principal Lieggi will participate in the Q & A session. Mr. Harvalis will be the teacher representative from Ames.
- The Illinois School Report Card for Ames Elementary School was presented by Principal Lieggi. The scores were very good overall with some highlights being 100% of students meeting or exceeding standards in 3rd grade mathematics, and 97.9% of students meeting or exceeding standards in both math and science for the 4th grade. Principal Lieggi credits a viable curriculum delivered by high quality teachers and students coming to school ready to learn with the overall high performance at Ames.

Flexible Boundary Committee Report, Mary Stimming -

The committee met two times per week over the past year to discuss the District 96 flexible boundary policy which was implemented in 2002. One parent from each school along with other interested parents comprised the committee. They also met once during the year with Dr. Lamberson and other District 96 Administrators. The findings of the committee will be presented at a meeting on Thursday, November 11th at 7:00 p.m. at Hauser.
