- Thursday, June 4 will be the last day for 5th graders/Clap Out.
- Science in a Bag Thanks to Serena and Matt Ranft, and Mrs. Allen for this program.

- Parent/Teacher Conferences are taking place on Friday, February 13
- The 5-for-4 laptop program Update
  - $_{\odot}$  The Project Manager position was approved. This program gives every 5<sup>th</sup> grader a laptop all the way through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Site visits to schools will take place on February 11. As to the question of cost, the district pays for upgrades and software. Equipment costs will be about \$150,000 in the first year. The salary of the project manager is within the District's salary structure.
